Control descriptions will follow the IOF Control Descriptions (ISCD2018)

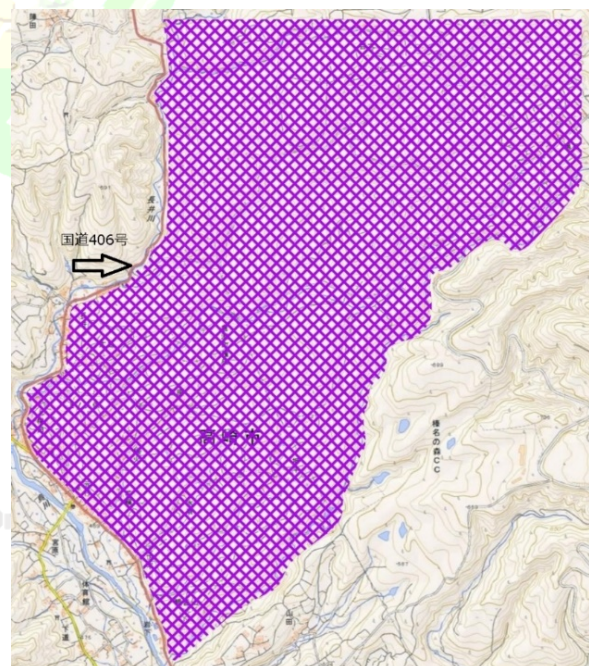
### ○Terrain Profile

The terrain is located on the west slope of Mt. Haruna, at around 550m-800m in altitude. Similar to Mt. Akagi, where the TUOLK Competition of 2018 was held, Mt. Haruna is formed by volcanic landforms. However, valleys are steep due to the erosion by the Karasu River. On the other hand, ridges are mostly flat, still keeping the features of volcanic landforms. If the weather is fine, the beautiful view of Mt. Asama can be seen.

Areas of high runnability and areas with thick bushes cover the terrain in patches. There are also some areas with low runnability due to fallen trees.
